

### WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19

#### ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of being allowed to use facilities for events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Attendance at events or activities includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my attendance; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for attendance as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I observe and any unusual or significant hazard during my presence, I will remove myself from the building and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Hartland Christian Camp, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other attendees, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, and owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

# Hartland Christian Camp Covid-19 Requirements for the 2021 Season

Every guest, whether a camper, counselor, speaker, etc., is currently required to sign and turn in a COVID waiver form and pre-camp screening form (below). Those attending with a group, please turn in to your group leader, who will submit as one bundled packet to the Hartland office. If attending as an individual or family, please turn in when checking in at the registration table.

## COVID-19 Pre-Camp Screening Form

Everyone traveling to Hartland must undergo this basic health screening **before** entering a vehicle.

- **Has not had any of the following symptoms:** Fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea.

**All answers must be “No” for camper to be eligible to attend camp.**

### Group Pre-Camp Screening Instructions: (Complete only if attending with Group)

(To be completed by group leader the day of event and prior to loading vehicles to camp.)

Visually inspect camper for signs of illness previously listed; if present, **Do Not** bring to camp.

**Face Masks:** Please bring one or more face masks depending on length of stay. Face masks will be required for all campers (age 2+), counselors, and staff. Please note that face masks are required when campers are not within their own cabin/pod groups and cannot maintain a distance of at least six feet from others. Scenarios like this will most likely occur when in line for events or meals or other types of event gatherings. Thank you for helping to ensure we meet health and safety requirements which will allow us to remain open to serve both your group and future groups.

**Cleaning and Sanitation:** Our employees strictly adhere to operating procedures at the highest level of compliance. Additionally, touchpoints such as door handles, restrooms, and handrails are cleaned and sanitized at an increased frequency.

**Temperatures:** Temperature will be taken each morning prior to breakfast with a contactless thermometer. Campers who exhibit illness or a fever above 100.3°F will be asked to isolate from other guests and return home as promptly as possible.
